

BRODHEAD PARK BOARD MINUTES MONDAY, 06 MAY 19

2019 SUMMER EMPLOYEE HIRES: Anyone wanting to apply for summer employment with the Brodhead Park & Rec Dept. had to have their application in by February 28th. On Monday, April 22nd, Stacie Baldwin, Zoe Tresemer and Wade interviewed 21 applicants. The names on the sheet marked with a (*) will be hired, pending they pass the lifeguard class they will be taking on May 18th, 19th & 25th, everyone was in favor. Wade will take the list to the City Council for final approval.

MAY REMINDERS: Wade handed out a May Reminder list. This list is a “to-do” list of what needs to be done during the month of May. It helps with getting things done in a timely manner. April and May are the two busiest months of Park & Rec.

REC PROGRAMS: Pete Claustro is teaching a 4 week soccer program that began on May 4th. There are 75 participants in the program and it is being offered at Marigil Park, south of the future dog park. New soccer goals and balls were purchased for this activity. Adult softball is underway; there is a Sunday night Church league (7 teams) and a Tuesday night 30 and over league (6 teams). Youth ball leagues will begin the first week of June. Teams have been formed.

OLD BUSINESS: With the help of Justin and Brad of the Streets Dept., the last of the scrub trees, brush and debris has been removed. Sager fencing is tentatively planning on installing the fence the week of April 22nd weather permitting. A gravel parking lot will be installed on the west side of the park to keep cars off the narrow street. Wade met with Brooke and Aaron Haycraft about setting up a cleanup day, also discussed rules and ordinances.

NEW BUSINESS: Pool Start-up is going to be Tuesday, May 14th and the first day the pool officially opens will be Tuesday, May 28th. There will be a lifeguarding class at the Brodhead Pool taught by Dave Gissing and Stacie Baldwin on May 18, 19 & 25. Currently there are 15 kids signed up for it.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS: The Park Board agreed to take the months of June and July off as like in previous years.
