

## Brodhead Public Works Committee Meeting Tuesday June 3, 2017

Call to order at 3:45 pm – Present: Rich Vogel, Holly Everson, Mary Mason.  
Motion to accept May minutes by Holly, second by Mary. Motion passed. (No June mtg)

Committee comments or questions: Mary asked how 15<sup>th</sup> St repaving was going to line up with the rest of 15<sup>th</sup> St. Rich explained the storm water situation on the north end of the city. Rich stated that the pump station is working as designed. Rich also reported that the Finance Committee is allowing the Street Department to spend the \$34,000 saved on the purchase of the end loader on street maintenance.

Tabled discussion on business district parking changes.

Rich reviewed the City Comprehensive Plan with the Committee.

Discussed the right of way at W 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue & what would be 23<sup>rd</sup> St and W 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 20<sup>th</sup> St. Motion by Holly, second by Mary to take to Council to have the right of ways sold to abutting property owners.

Rich showed the Committee the new SCADA system.

Rich gave an update on the Phosphorus Trading Plan.

Rich informed the committee that we have paid out \$15,190 for 34 Ash tree removals. We still have around 120 more to be remove with a total expected cost of around \$100,000 this year. We expect to have around 135 Ash trees that will need to be removed in 2018 at an expected cost of around \$80,000.

Discussed budget. Committee was very disappointed that the audit was still not completed. Committee feels the city should look at hiring a different company since this company has failed to deliver an earlier audit as they had promised.
