Brodhead Public Works/Forestry Committee Meeting  
Minutes for June 2, 2020

- Call to order at 3:45 PM
- Present: Rich Vogel, Holly Everson, Mary Mason, Barb Krattiger, Tim Schadewaldt .
- Discuss/Possible Action approval of March minutes: Motion by Mary, second by Holly to approve minutes. Motion carried.
- Public Appearances – Discussed a driveway issue due to the weight of the end loader. Rich is going to discuss options with the resident. Rich also informed the Committee that Jeremy Pinnow is requesting “No Parking” on 10<sup>th</sup> Street in front of his storage sheds.
- Phosphorus projects: Rich updated the Committee on the progress of the projects and informed the Committee that a letter was sent to Nelson Excavating giving them to June 30<sup>th</sup> to complete the Searls Creek project.
- Spring clean-up issues and date; Date for Spring Clean-up has been moved to October 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>. Committee discussed past problems and how to avoid those problems this year.
- Wastewater Facility Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR) – Rich informed the Committee we received an “A” in every area of the report and now the resolution needs to be passed by the City Council. Motion by Holly, second by Barb to recommend that the City Council pass the resolution. Motion carried.
- Street projects update: Rich informed the Committee that we received one bid for seal coating from Fahrner Asphalt. Our Engineer recommended accepting the bid. Motion by Barb, second by Mary to recommend that the City Council accept the bid for \$104,847.00 from Fahrner Asphalt. Motion carried.  
Rich informed the Committee that we received two proposals for concrete repair work. This would include the broken curb areas in the business district, the sidewalk at the Historical building and some gutter repairs. Motion by Holly, second by Barb to accept the proposal from Rock Solid Concrete for \$13,490.00. Motion carried.
- Budget; Discussed budget. No action.
- Committee comments or questions: Mary commented that some residents were blowing grass onto the street. Committee discussed ways to handle it. It was suggested that when you see someone doing that to contact the Police Department.
