FALL FOOTBALL: With High School and Middle School football not happening this fall, Wade will not be doing the flag football program. Wade has an idea of a doing a 4-week passing league, it would have little to no contact; this program could take place in late September and October if everything is going well with the kids back to school. SUMMER PARK PROJECTS: This summer many park improvements have been done. The older playground equipment at Putnam Park along with the benches, concrete cylinders and planter all have been painted. The signs around the Jaycee playground equipment were stained and the wood fencing at Legion Park is being stained this week. The weeds were pulled at the sandbox in Putnam, the Legion Playground and volleyball courts were rototilled to remove encroaching grass and weeds. The Jaycee Park Restrooms that are under renovation will have new metal siding in a couple weeks. Kyle Braund's Eagle Scout project installing railroad ties and mulch around the center playground equipment is a nice improvement. The dirt area around the outside of the mulch area has been seeded down with grass seed. These projects have been huge improvements to our parks. Our last project is to paint the pool house.

REC PROGRAMS: We finished up the 4-week youth ball program. The Sunday and Tuesday night softball will wrap up at the end of August. T-ball and Tots on the Run has two weeks left.

OLD BUSINESS: The swimming pool is filling and Badger Swim Pools will be down Wednesday to start it up. Getting the pool up and running is preventative maintenance. This allows us the opportunity to see if there are any mechanical issues that need to be addressed. Also, over time antifreeze does not maintain its strength over a long period of time. The pool will be circulating for about 2 weeks and then emptied and re-winterized. The Dog Park was closed Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>- July 15<sup>th</sup> for park maintenance and updates.

NEW BUSINESS: The Brodhead Sports Boosters will be having a Softball Tournament the weekend of August  $7^{th}$  –  $9^{th}$  at Legion Park. Chris Hoesly will be the contact.

Paul Roemer expressed the idea of having flags installed around the planter at Putnam Park, this planter has 10 threaded receptacles where the flags could be installed. The planter leads to the Pearl Island Bridge. These flags might interest the attention of visitors to the many other attractions around the City of Brodhead.
