

PARK BOARD MINUTES
05 DEC 16

Council Rep – Paul Huffman

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Members present included: Presley Hale, Paul Huffman, Lewie Schliem, Wally Wilson and Wade Boegli. Absent: Missy Kuebli. The previous minutes were read and approved.

PUTNAM PARK RESTROOMS: The Brodhead Foundation has given \$40,900.00 towards replacement restrooms at Putnam Park. The new restrooms replace the old ones that we have used for 59 years. Wade has set up the first meeting on Wednesday, December 7 between Rich Edwards the representative with CXT Buildings and Steve Schnieder, the Parks Department's plumber, to get the project in motion. Wade also prepared a thank you letter to the Brodhead Area Foundation that all members of the Park Board signed.

REC PROGRAMS: Volleyball leagues have begun. The two coed leagues are on Wednesday and Sunday nights. Wednesday has 4 teams and Sunday has 6 teams.

OLD BUSINESS: Currently the parks department finished up its fall maintenance in the parks, which consisted of leaf removal, pruning, aerating and mowing.

NEW BUSINESS: Park Reservations will begin Tuesday, January 3rd at 9:00 A.M.; notices have gone out to the newspapers. Summer applications will be available on Tuesday, January 3rd also. Applications must be returned by February 28th. The 2nd & 3rd grade basketball program sign-up is underway. 3rd grade will meet for 4 Wednesdays in January and 2nd grade will meet for 4 Wednesdays in February.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS: With the first Monday in January falling on the City's Holiday, the board agreed to not meet in January and meet back again in February.
