REC PROGRAMS: The winter volleyball league on Sunday night is going well. It is a coed league that involves 7th graders and older to play. There are 8 teams in the league. A few weeks ago, Wade completed ball diamond maintenance to the 3 diamonds at Legion Park. The diamonds were edged and ag lime brought in to fill low areas and a crushed granite material called Turface was applied by a top dressing machine. The completion of this project will offer a safer and improved playing surface for anyone using these diamonds.

OLD BUSINESS: Wade handed out a Fall Reminder list to everyone. This list is a “to-do” list of everything that needs to be done in the parks before the snow comes. Aaron and Brooke Haycraft have formed a dog park committee and an application has been submitted to the Brodhead Foundation for the fencing of the future dog park located on 11th St.

NEW BUSINESS: The Brodhead Foundation has given the Brodhead Park and Rec Dept. the money for the fencing for the future Dog Park. The project is projected to get underway in the spring of 2019. Park Reservations will be accepted starting Thursday, January 3rd. Summer applications for the employment for the 2019 season will be accepted from January 3rd – February 28th. Wade will be offering a 2nd and 3rd grade youth basketball program for boys and girls. 3rd graders will participate in January and 2nd graders in February on Wednesday afternoons.
