

PARK BOARD MINUTES
04 MAY 15

Chairman – Lewie Schliem, Council Rep – Troy Nyman, Secretary – Missy Kuebli

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Members present included: Troy Nyman, Lewie Schliem, Wally Wilson and Wade Boegli. Absent: Missy Kuebli, Becky Malkow and Troy Gerber. The previous minutes were read and approved.

JUNE & JULY MEETINGS: Wade asked the board if it would be okay to take off the months of June and July due to coaching. The board was fine with that. Troy N also coaches the youth. We would meet again in August before Covered Bridge Days or if something very important comes up, we would have a special meeting.

MAY REMINDERS: Wade handed out his May Reminder list to the board; this is a “to-do” list of what needs to be done during the month of May.

REC PROGRAMS: Youth ball teams/leagues have been formed. The leagues will begin the first week of June.

Church softball just got underway Sunday night and the Tuesday and Wednesday night leagues will begin this week. Unfortunately after 19 years, there will not be a women’s league.

Adult sand volleyball leagues will start Thursday, May 7th. There are 13 teams playing in the coed A & B. Pickleball is playing at the Middle School parking lot. There are 4 courts painted on the parking lot.

OLD BUSINESS: Wade is going to look into signage for the Decatur Dam Park and Headgates Park. Currently there is no signage identifying either area.

NEW BUSINESS: The lifeguard chairs at the pool have been replaced with money left from last years’ pool budget. Outdoor matting was added to the batting cage at Legion Park. This was purchased from the ticket fundraiser. New volleyball nets have been installed at Jaycee Park. Last year, the nets had been cut. 3 pallets of field dressing have been added to the big diamond at Legion Park.

Wade will start filling the swimming pool, Monday May 18th and Badger Pools will be down on Wednesday, May 20th to start it up. The pool will be open for swimming beginning Tuesday, May 26th for half days, until the kids get out of school.

Wade expressed the interest of a dog park in the area north of Marigil Park, south of the railroad tracks and exchanging Marigil Park with the City. The Park Board was not in favor.
